The children have worked very hard on their Christmas card designs and we are sure you will want to order these.

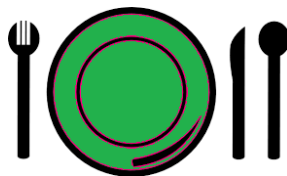
Please remember that orders need to be in school by Monday 15th October in order that they can be sent to the printers in good time. Thank you.
