Mrs Pizzey is holding this competition once again in school next Tuesday (27th March).

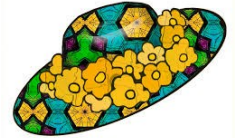
If children wish to take part, they need to bring in a decorated hard boiled egg with their name on a little card to show whose it is.

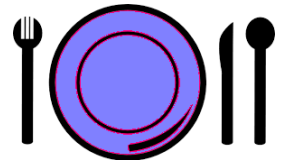
### Dinner Money
