This Week in School

Non-Uniform Days – OPAL Project: As part of our Outdoor Play and Learning Project, we will be holding non-uniform days each half term in return for donations to enhance our outdoor play provision. Children will come to school in their own clothes and, in return, should donate a bag of items (it doesn't need to be a full bag!) which can be played with in the yard. We have already started to collect donations and the play and children's ideas in the yard have been amazing! The types of things we are looking for are as follows:

- pots and pans, plastic cups, bowls, plates, picnic hampers
- anything with wheels (or even wheels themselves not attached to anything!)
- handbags, briefcases, suitcases
- dressing up outfits, hats, props
- buggies (full size or toy size)
- small world toys (cars, trains, character toys, McDonalds type plastic characters)
- sheets and blankets
- rugs
- crates and planks of wood
- old keyboards/phones
- garden chairs
- tents
- instruments
- anything that children could make a game from using their imagination

Moving forward – before you throw anything out, please consider whether we could free-cycle it for you first! Parents can donate items any time (we understand you won't want to keep it stored at home once you've decided to get rid), but the two dates for non-uniform days this term are as follows:

Parent Questionnaire: As you are aware, we welcome parent feedback at any time in the year and we regularly receive emails and have conversations with parents that help us improve what we do. Once a year, we formalise this and invite all parents to give us their views. We use an electronic system to make this process simpler and quicker for parents.

The link for the parent questionnaire will be sent out early next week to the email address we have as your child's first contact. Please help us by completing this and giving us as much detail as possible where the questions request a more 'full' response. If you do not have access to the internet to complete this; let us know and we will provide a paper copy.

In the past, the reponses to the parent questionnaire have led to improvements to our school such as the installation of the new fences and electronic entry system; the introduction of the mini-written report you receive at your termly parent meetings so you have an accurate understanding of your child's progress and targets; changes to the homework given to our children; termly Share and Stay sessions for key curriculum areas; the introduction of the Facebook and Twitter pages and changes to the school website (about to be launched) to keep you more informed about what we do in school on a day to day basis; the wider use of text messaging to parents and parent e-safety sessions.

Similarly, feedback from the pupil questionnaire has led to the OPAL (Outdoor Play and Learning) project that we have just begun to use to develop our break and

lunchtimes; changes to how the children are served lunch, and the revised behaviour management system introduced last year which has contributed towards us now grading behaviour and behaviour for learning in school as Outstanding.
