**Miss Ellison:** Huge congratulations to Miss Ellison who is expecting a baby in August. I am sure you will join me in sending our best wishes to her.

**Year 3 Visit to Gibside:** As we have now paid the balance of this visit to Gibside, all outstanding payments need to be cleared by the end of this week – as stated in a recent newsletter. This will also mean that payments cannot be refunded if your child decides they no longer wish to go.

**Payment Arrears:** I am becoming very concerned at the amount of arrears certain parents are accumulating on their accounts – mainly lunch payments. The majority of parents and carers pay on time but there are a few parents who consistently have to be contacted by the school office to be reminded to pay their debts. I feel we are lenient at Prudhoe West compared to other schools, and we try to be understanding when parents cannot pay, but this is unfair on the parents and carers who do pay regularly and on time.

Moving forward, from 16<sup>th</sup> April 2018, all arrears must be cleared. If parents are unable to clear their arrears by this date, then they should make an appointment to speak to me in person. Lunch payments must be made one week **in advance**. If you have not paid on the Monday, we will send you a reminder text and will continue to do so daily until the payment is made. This is in line with procedures in other schools in the Trust. Parents who still fail to pay will be referred to the finance department at Wise Head Office, who will take formal action to recover the debt. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

Shining Stars: the majority of parents and carers pay online as they book sessions, but I would like to remind those parents who book via telephone or pay with vouchers, that they too must pay in advance or on the day of the session **at the latest**.

**Lateness:** I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that you have a legal responsibility to ensure your children attend school regularly and on time. As well as monitoring attendance, we also monitor lateness and there are a few children who are consistently late for school. Lateness results in children missing out on valuable learning time, and those minutes each morning mount up to hours and days over the school year. Since September 124 hours (that is a month of school days!) of education have been missed across school due to lateness!

A few schools in the country have now started to fine parents of children who are frequently late; we would rather not go down that route but feel we need to take a stronger stance before the situation escalates. We will be sending out 'late' letters and text messages to the parents of those children this applies to.
