



Oceans and Seas Medium Term Plan

Year 2 - Autumn 1

<p><u>English</u> Information texts: the children will know the features of nonfiction books and be able to use the index. Children will create their own information text on a chosen sea creature. Children will learn about local sea creatures. Labels, lists and signs.</p> <p>Children will be able to label and discuss different sea creatures, they will be able to make lists consisting of animals who live in certain areas in and around the sea.</p> 	<p><u>Maths</u> Children will develop a range of skills through recording written work and exploration. They will develop their approach to problem solving and work towards a mastery understanding in number.</p> <p>Children will be taught place value, addition and subtraction. Crosscurricular links will be made and skills developed in context.</p> 	<p><u>Geography/history</u> Use geographical language. Use fieldwork skills for example, recording information on a school plan or local area map. Use globes, maps and plans at a range of scales [for example, following a route on a map]. Use secondary sources of information [for example, pictures, photographs, make maps and plans. Make observations about where things are located. Place events and objects in chronological order. Use common words and phrases relating to the passing of time [for example, before, after, a long time ago, past. Recognise why people did things, why events happened and what happened as a result. Identify differences between ways of life at different times.</p> 	<p><u>Science</u> Children will learn about animals their habitats and basic needs. They will learn that animals, including humans grow into adults and have offspring.</p> <p>Children will learn the importance of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food and hygiene.</p>	<p><u>Art</u> Children will look at camouflage and animal habitats.</p> 
<p><u>SPAG</u> SPAG ongoing throughout all lessons. One weekly SPAG lesson with a specific focus. Spellings, homework and handwriting linked to the weekly SPAG lesson.</p>	<p><u>R.E</u> Children will learn about Hinduism. They will learn the story of Rama and Sita and about scared animals.
