Last week we received some very sad reports from one of our neighbours who had witnessed anti-social behaviour on a patch of land that they look after for the community. Children wearing our school uniform had been repeatedly peering in at their windows then running away, and then destroying their flowers - daffodils and tulips. The most recent incident had happened after school on Thursday between 3.30pm and 4.30pm. This was very upsetting to our neighbours, and to us. Our Year 4s, 3s and 2s have been spoken to about the complaint, and our Year 4s offered to write letters to our neighbours explaining their shock and sadness at such behaviour.
