

Rothbury First School PE & Sports Premium Information

The Government provides £150 million per year to schools to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all children. The funding is ring-fenced and can only be spent on PE and sport provision in schools. Rothbury First School has used this funding to ensure that all pupils have access to high quality PE, appropriate sporting competition and opportunities to lead a healthy and active lifestyle.

2018-2019 Planned PE and Sports Premium Expenditure

The school's allocation of funds for PE and Sports Premium is based upon our pupil census numbers.

In 2018-19, we were allocated a total of £16,882 in our 2018-19 budget.

We plan to spend the premium as follows:

Amount	Plans:	Impact upon our children (to be added in Summer Term 2019)
£4000	Provision of a specialist PE teacher in school to deliver high quality PE lessons to our pupils for half a day a week.	
£750	Provision of a specialist Yoga teacher to teach Yoga for three half terms.	
£2000	Provision of specialised coaches: cricket, football, rugby league, etc.	
£1052	Support for transport to swimming lessons.	
£720	Support for children to attend sporting festivals, to include the cost of transport where applicable.	

£380	Contribution towards the cost of the Year 4 Robinwood Activity Residential Feb 2019.	
£480	Contribution towards the cost of the Year 4 Ford Castle Activity Residential Feb 2019.	
£250	Support for bikeability lessons - provision of supervising adults.	
£4000	Support for 'mile a day' activity - provision of supervising adults.	
£1500	Provision of training for teachers.	
£600	Support for after-school clubs - provision of facilities	
£50	Support for summer soccer camp - provision of facilities	
£550	Support for Forest School - outdoor First Aid certificate	
£550	Support for PE - Paediatric First Aid certificate
