## Personal Social & Emotional (PSE)

Become confident in talking to others in play and in asking adults for help.

Forming good relationships with peers and adults, demonstrating friendly behaviour.

Follow rules and routines  
Playing in a group, extending and elaborating ideas.

## Understanding of the World

Talk about significant events in own experience.

Talk about why things happen and how things work

Talk about similarities and differences in relation to family and friends

## Communication & Language

Following directions and simple instructions

Listen to stories with increasing attention and recall.

Understand prepositions such as under, on top, behind

Building vocabulary  
Using more complex sentences

## Maths

Counting to 10 begin to recognise numbers to 10  
Compare two groups of objects knowing when they have the same number

Positional language  
Talk about the shapes of everyday objects.

## Literacy

Letters and Sounds - the environment and instrumental sounds.

Listen and join in with nursery rhymes and stories

Give meaning to the marks they make as they draw and paint

## Physical Development (PD)

Put coat on independently.

Developing gross and fine motor control through mark making and sensory play.

Use tools and equipment including scissors.

Becoming more independent in self care

## Expressive Arts and Design

Sing a few familiar songs and nursery rhymes  
Move in response to music

Begin to describe the texture of things

Begin to know that tools can be used for a specific purpose
