#### SO FAR THIS HALF TERM...

We have had a very busy start to this final half term. Our new Unit Manager, Alison Bolton, has started serving school lunches and we wish her well in her new post. Two students from KEVI, May and Cara, completed a week of work experience: it was a pleasure having them work with us!

Out and about: our Year 3 and 4 children had an amazing visit to the Children's Countryside Day in Wooler – thank you again to the volunteers that day – we couldn't have done it without you.

Our Year 2, 3 and 4 children have all started their "tennis taster" sessions with Phil Barron. These will be leading up to a festival later this term.

Staff from the Middle School have visited our Year 4 children to continue their work in preparation for transition to the Middle School.

Across school and in all year groups, our period of assessment has now completed: this has included the Reception Early Years profiles, the Year 1 phonics screening and the Year 2 external assessments. We are now working on your end-of-year reports which will come out to you in the next couple of weeks.

Our Year 3 and 4 children have all attended workshops for Show Racism the Red Card. The children found this a very worthwhile day. We then had a wonderful afternoon hosted by the Year 8s from the Middle School as part of their Archbishop of York leadership awards. Our children attended workshops which included baking (Year 1), card-making (Year 2), Spanish (Year 3) and transition (Year 4) and all took part in sporting workshops.

We hosted a multi-skills festival for our children. Unfortunately the other schools invited were unable to attend this time. Our Year 4s then enjoyed their final trumpet lesson with Mr Vallance. He will be returning in the Autumn term to teach our new Year 3 and Year 4s.

This week finished with a super cake sale by the Friends of Rothbury First School. This was very well attended and over £140 was raised.

Thank you again to the parents who attended our meeting on Monday with our governors and staff. We hope that this was useful to you and that it clarified any queries that you may have had about the class structures for September.

Our current total of monies raised by the Children's Cancer Run stands at £2,841.09 which is fantastic! Well done everyone.
