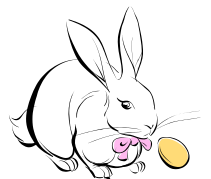

PE days and after school clubs for summer term A

PE lessons during summer term A will be-

Orange class- please come to school wearing PE kit on Monday;

Yellow class- Wednesday and Friday; Green class- Tuesday and Friday;

Red class- Tuesday and Thursday; Blue class- Tuesday and Thursday.

Children will need their **school PE kit** (white t-shirt and dark shorts) and **trainers** for all PE lessons and after school clubs.
