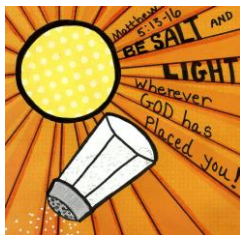

Do we as adults let them shine?

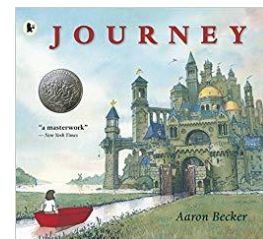
Do we hide them?
