

### September return to school organisation

As per government guidelines school attendance is mandatory again from September, unless there are any further lockdowns.

In school we are going to be concentrating on a recovery plan which will include the whole community. Initially we will focus on the mental health of the children so that they feel secure in school. Alongside this we will be working with the children to re-establish the correct attitude for learning.

Returning to school in September is going to be quite fluid initially so that we can cater for children's emotional needs. There will be a phased start for some children as returning may appear stressful for them.

- The new Nursery, Reception and Year 1 have received letters from their teachers that explain how they are to begin the new school year.
- The children in Years 2-6 who are with us in school now will begin attending full time from Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September.
- The children in Years 2-6 who have been home learning throughout the Lockdown will begin a phased return on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September with full time attendance expected from week beginning Monday 7<sup>th</sup> September.
- These children will be allotted a group A or B. Children will attend school for a short period of time each day in the first week as in the table below. You will be informed by email which group your child is in.

Routines for coming into school and leaving at the end of the school day have to be well organised and all parents and children will have follow the safety measures.

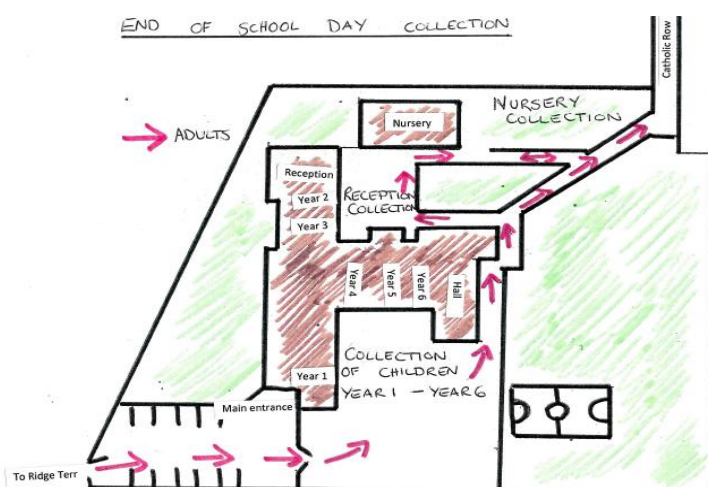
The staggered start to the day is organised by your family name and all adults and children will enter the school site via the Catholic Row entrance. **All adults** will exit through the Ridge Terrace gate that we share with St Benet Biscop meaning walking through the staff car park. There is **no entrance through the staff car park in the morning**.



These are the allotted times for dropping children off.

The staggered collection times are also organised by your family name and all adults will enter the school site via Ridge Terrace and through the gate we share with St Benet Biscop, walking through the staff car park to the yard space. There will be spots painted for adults on the yards to ensure distancing of adults. **All adults and children** will then exit through the Catholic Row entrance gate. **There is no exit through the staff car park in the afternoon.**

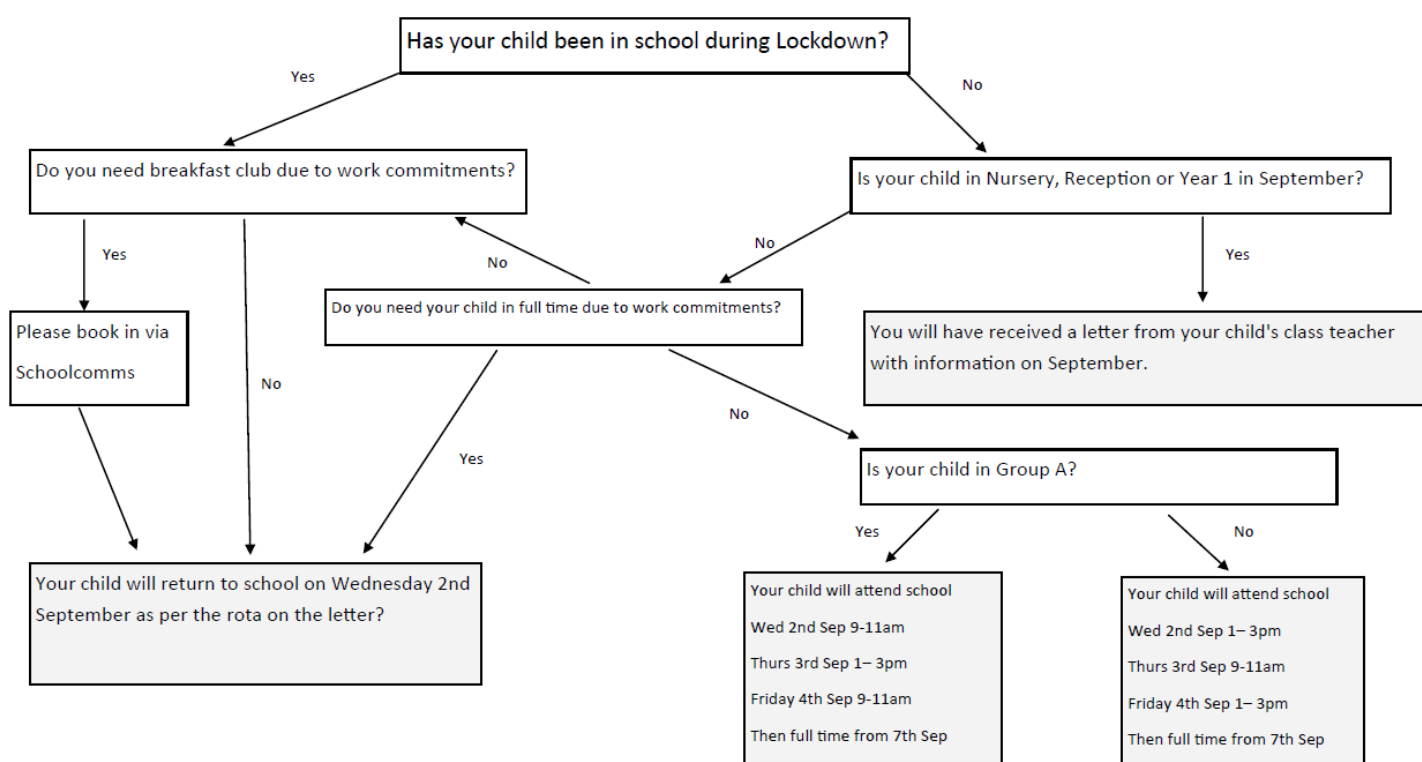
- To minimise the numbers of adults on the school site we also expect that only one adult brings a family of children to school. It would be advantageous to share school drop of and collection if possible. For example cousins could come with one family member.
- Catholic Row and the Church car park will **not** be open for school parking. This is a safety measure as all children will be accessing by foot. Children are also not to bring bikes and scooters to school for the first half term as we assess the new measures.
- If your child is booked in for B n T then the staff car park can be used with extra caution. The car park will be open between 7.30am - 8.10am then after 3.45pm. Cars are to be reverse parked and children will enter the out of school club via the hall door. These sessions **must** be pre booked.

Lunches in the Autumn term will again be via our catering providers at St Benet Biscop Academy and will be ordered on the iPayimpact system. Mrs Miles is extending the menu to allow some hot food. The children will eat in their classrooms to maintain the bubble system.

Please ensure that you have registered your child for iPayimpact as we are no longer using Schoolcomms for lunches. 

When the children come to school they will only need to bring their reading book and the school water bottle (not branded water bottles). There are to be no bags brought to school apart from a Wednesday when they will need PE kits from Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> September.
