












**Summary of Work
Year Four
Summer 1 Term 2017**



RE	<p>In RE this term, children will know and understand building bridges of friendship. In addition, they will explore and understand the importance of admitting wrong and being reconciled with one another and God. Furthermore, children will acquire the skills of assimilation, celebration and application of the above.</p>

English	<p>In literacy children will learn to write a narrative story based on pirates as well as learn the skills to compose a detailed biography on the infamous pirate, William Kidd. In addition, children will also write a diary from the perspective of a selected crew member on a pirate ship.</p>
Maths 	<p>In Maths children will be learning to add two 2-digit numbers or a 2-digit number to a 3- or 4-digit number mentally. In addition, children will acquire the skills to subtract 2-, 3- and 4-digit numbers using counting up. They will also derive factors of 2-digit numbers and use factors and doubling to solve multiplication mentally as well as solve integer scaling problems using mental strategies and spot a relationship between products.</p>
Science 	<p>In science children will understand how a food chain works as well as understand and interpret a food web. In addition children will be able to know the terminology of food chains and food webs.</p>
History	

	<p>In history children will learn about the types of ship used in pirate times as well as learn about the different roles in a pirate crew.</p>
<p>Geography</p> 	<p>Children will locate countries where pirates have attacked and continue to attack today.</p>
<p>Music</p> 	<p>Children will continue to learn to violin throughout this half term and will be practising their 'Glastonbede songs'.</p>
<p>Art</p> 	<p>In art children will be learning to make a clay sculpture linked to our creative curriculum topic of Treasure Trove.</p>
<p>Technology</p> 	<p>In technology children will be designing and making a pirate ship.</p>
<p>P4C/PHSE</p>	<p>The children will learn to explore ideas and thoughts through discussion and learn to listen to the opinions of others and accept that not everyone will agree on an answer.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>The children will learn how to create, edit and refine complex sequences of instructions for a variety of programmable devices such as 'Scratch'. Children will also use a computer to create a basic application, including simple variables.</p>
<p>PE</p> 	<p>In PE this term children will be taking part in athletics.</p>
