I would like to congratulate you, your staff and your pupils for your school's very high standard of achievement in the 2016 phonics screening check.

We want to ensure that every child develops a firm grasp of phonics which is why I was delighted to see your results. With at least 95 per cent of pupils at Wooler First School reaching or exceeding the pass mark in the check, your school is in the top 8 per cent of all primary schools in the country.

This year's figures show 89 per cent of pupils who achieve the expected standard in the check go on to achieve at least the expected standard in key stage 1 reading, which underlines the value of developing the ability to decode words effectively at an early age.

I am pleased to hear that you have ensured your Year One children at Wooler First School have a firm foundation in reading, from which they can develop further and become increasingly fluent readers. This will help them develop a lifelong love of reading.
