Election Day – Thursday 6th May 2021

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are aware, it is Election Day next Thursday 6th May. As in the past, the Small Hall and Community Centre here at Woodloes Primary School, will be used as a polling station. We want to assure you that we have worked very closely with Warwickshire County Council to ensure that the relevant risk assessments are in place to ensure the safety of the pupils, parents, staff and the public. There will be two marshalls provided by Warwickshire County Council to ensure that the public using the polling station will not come into close contact with pupils and parents / carers.

There will be a couple of changes that will impact on some of the pupils (but not all).

OSCAR

Dropping off and collecting children on Thursday 6th May will be through the main school office reception, rather than through the gate by the small hall. Please bear with us if there is a little delay in your child being collected or delivered to you.

Years 5 and 6

The side gate (by the school car park) will be used by voters and therefore will not be accessible to pupils and parents. Therefore, **for Thursday 6th May only**, we request that all Year 5 and 6 pupils enter onto the school site through the gate next to Evergreen / alongside Saplings, without their parents / carers and make their way round to their classrooms via the playground. At the end of the day they will exit through the side gate (in between the bike sheds). We recommend that they are either collected at the side gate or at the front of school (they will walk up to be collected). We anticipate that the inconvenience caused by using the school as a polling station will be kept to a minimum, but we appreciate your patience and understanding on the day.
