Religious and Moral Education takes place throughout the age ranges. Through R.E. we aim to inspire tolerance and spiritual awareness. We follow the Local Authority Agreed Syllabus, and while it is mainly Christian in nature, children are introduced to all the major World Religions. Emphasis is placed on valuing and respecting each other as individuals and establishing a code of conduct for life, broadly based in a Christian ethos. The beliefs and customs of other religions are taught, and links within them highlighted.

Parents have the right to withdraw their children from R.E. lessons. Any parent wishing to exercise this right should contact the head teacher.
