Admissions Criteria Arrangements

Stocksfield Avenue has clear procedures for admitting new pupils to the school in order to ensure fairness.

ADMISSIONS POLICY FOR NURSERY CLASSES

The targeted age group for nursery classes attached to schools is pupils who have reached their third birthday on or before 31st August of the year they are admitted.

Places are allocated using the criteria below:

- i) The presence of a brother or sister in the nursery unit or in the main primary school linked to the unit.
- ii) Any special, social or medical reasons in line with LA policy for reception classes.
- iii) The address of the child relative to the school.

The nursery can accommodate 39 pupils (78 half day sessions) at any time made up of a combination of 15 hour places and 30 hour places per week. We deliver the part time places over two and a half days. Application forms are available from the school and returnable to the school by the Easter of the year of admission.

Applications for admission to the Reception class or Year 6 transfers to secondary school should be made to the Local Authority via their Admissions Section on 0191 2328520 or via their website at www.newcastle.gov.uk/admissions
