Lunch Money

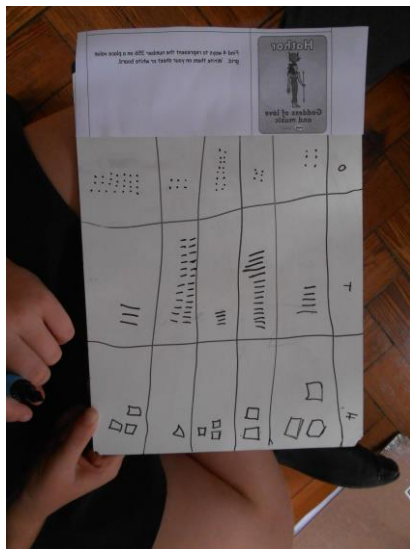

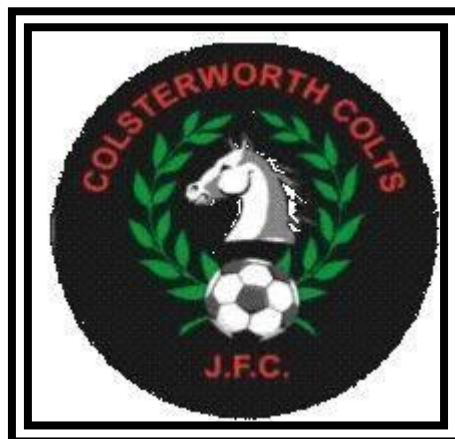
