## Nasal Flu Vaccine

You will now have returned the consent form for your child to be allowed to have the nasal flu vaccine, if they are in Reception – Year 5. This will be on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> October. We have received the following information from Northumbria Healthcare to pass on to you:

“It has come to our attention that the information about the porcine gelatin may not have reached all parents as there have been insufficient leaflets to go round everyone.

The nasal flu vaccine contains products derived from pigs (porcine gelatin). There is no suitable alternative flu immunisation available for otherwise healthy children.
