

Key Stage Three Curriculum



SUBJECT	CURRICULUM DELIVERY
Communication, language & literacy	Is embedded across the curriculum and will also be taught in 1:1, small group, class and 'structured teaching' sessions. SALT weekly sessions. Library sessions.
Maths	Is embedded across the curriculum and will also be taught in 1:1, small group, class and 'structured teaching' sessions. The School shop, reception etc. provide opportunities for 'making maths real.' Maths Week'.
Knowledge & understanding of the World	
Science	Will be taught in discrete class sessions with reinforcement where appropriate in cross curricular activities and within class routines.
History	History will be taught using a subject specific/cross curricular approach, including the 'Daily Morning Class Sessions', the use of a symbol timetables.
Geography	Geography will be taught using a subject specific/cross curricular approach.
RE	RE will be taught through exploration of Festivals, Assemblies and events supported by the Brent RE Syllabus. Collective Worship/ reflection will take place daily.
Computing	Computing will be taught through discrete class lessons and through cross curricular activities.

PSHE	PSHE and Self-help skills will be taught through the use of class routines, particularly focussing on arrival times, meal times, playtimes, home times, assemblies and choosing times, with some specific topic lessons -R (Friends) Time.
Music, Art, PE, Swimming, Dance, Yoga, Drama	These subjects are primarily taught by subject teachers supported and developed by the class teacher.
