### Article 19

Our children have the right to be protected from being hurt and mistreated in body and mind

### Article 23

A child with a disability has the right to participate fully in the life of the school. You have the right to special education and care if you have a disability

### Article 24

Our children have the right to the best health care, fresh water, nutritious food and a clean and safe environment

### Article 28

Our children have the right to an education. Discipline in school must respect children's dignity

## What should adults in school do?

- ◆ Make time to listen and take action when needed
- ◆ Hold regular school council meetings

- ◆ Provide a safe environment
- ◆ Follow safeguarding policies
- ◆ Be kind, calm and considerate
- ◆ Set clear boundaries

- ◆ Provide a curriculum which meets the needs of individual learners
- ◆ Ensure trips and visits take into account the needs of children with SEND
- ◆ Encourage participation in extra curricular activities

- ◆ Teach children about healthy choices
- ◆ Provide clean water bottles
- ◆ Ensure children have fair access to healthy food

- ◆ Provide a rich, broad and balanced curriculum
- ◆ Follow the behaviour policy and make sure all children are treated fairly
- ◆ Establish an ethos of mutual respect

## What should children do?

- ◆ Be confident to speak up
- ◆ Agree and disagree respectfully
- ◆ Know when to speak and when to listen

- ◆ Ask for help when needed
- ◆ Know who to ask for help
- ◆ Be kind, calm and considerate
- ◆ Take care of their friends

- ◆ Offer help and support to their friends with SEND, when needed
- ◆ Show respect and treat everyone equally
- ◆ Ask for help when required
- ◆ Always try their best

- ◆ Make healthy choices
- ◆ Look after their own and school property
- ◆ Keep the school clean and tidy
- ◆ Take care of the environment

- ◆ Always try their best
- ◆ Try new things even when they are a challenge
- ◆ Take responsibility for their own actions

## What should parents do?

- ◆ Make time to talk to children about school
- ◆ Listen to their children
- ◆ Talk to teachers about what children say

- ◆ Provide a safe environment
- ◆ Know who to ask for help
- ◆ Be kind, calm and considerate

- ◆ Talk to teachers about their children's needs
- ◆ Attend Parent meetings
- ◆ Ask for advice and guidance if required
- ◆ Encourage children to attend extra curricular activities

- ◆ Give their children healthy meals and drinks
- ◆ Encourage children to develop self help skills such as washing themselves and brushing their teeth
- ◆ Provide clean clothes for children to wear

- ◆ Support the school curriculum and ethos
- ◆ Encourage children to complete their homework; help them to do this when necessary
