## WHO ARE THE GOVERNORS?

The Governors are a mix of 13 parents and other local people who have a special interest in our school and how it works. Sarah White is chair of the governing body.

We meet every half term for an evening of discussion about what is going on, review policies and consider anything that affects our school.

As well as our main Full Governing Body meetings, we have two committees. These are:

**Teaching and Learning (T&L)**, chaired by Simone Stevens, which looks at the curriculum, Special Educational Needs, data and assessment.

**Resources and Safeguarding (R&S)**, chaired by Matt Jobe, which discusses anything related to school finances and health and safety in school.

To see if we are doing the right thing, there are nationally set questions to help us review what we do. These questions include

- Do we have the right skills on the Governing body?
- How do we review school policies?
- Does our financial management get good value for money?
- How do we collaborate with other schools?

We may first discuss matters with the Head Teacher and the Chair of Governors before issues are considered by the full Governing Body.

Governors are volunteers, typically very dedicated to the school and, able to give a great deal of time in order to fulfil their role. Governors work as a team. We are responsible for making sure that Kea School provides high quality education. First and foremost we maintain confidentiality and fully participate in the work of the Governing Body, for example - serving on committees and working groups, attending meetings, and contributing to discussions. Visiting the school and taking part in school events is an important aspect. We attend training and this is usually provided by the Local Authority.

Governors agree the school aims and policies. We do this together with the Headteacher, who is responsible for the day-to-day management of the school. We interview and select the Headteacher, and with the Headteacher make decisions on the school's budget and staffing.

In order for governors to be more visible to staff, parents and pupils, each governor has been assigned a year group as well as a subject. Below is a list of the governors with their corresponding year groups and linked subjects.
