Be punctual	Arrive on time, fully equipped for the start of lessons.
Be co-operative	Accept advice and guidance from your teacher and follow instructions.
Be considerate	Show respect for other people and their property. Consider how your actions help or hinder others. Listen respectfully to others.
Be focused	Remain on task and try to improve on your previous best.
Be ambitious	Make a real effort and aim for excellence in your work.

Whenever you are in uniform you represent our community, you are expected to:

Respect yourself	Think about the effect of your words and actions on others. Be truthful. Look smart in the correct uniform.
Respect others	Take a stand against bullying or unkindness. When travelling to school be polite and co-operative. In school, be aware of others -hold the door open, avoid pushing or running. Talk and behave quietly respecting others' needs. Racist, offensive or bullying language or swearing is not acceptable.
Respect the environment	Treat the things around you with respect- put rubbish in the bin, leave chewing gum at home, use resources carefully and recycle where possible, avoid damage or graffiti.
