On 14th June a fire occurred on the 24 storey, 220 foot high tower block of public housing flats in London. With 34 confirmed deaths and the number expected to rise to around 80, as well as the life changing impact it has had on so many families, we talked a lot about the disaster and classes at the time. Year 5 and 6 wrote letters to children in schools affected by the disaster and last week we received a reply to letters sent off by 5M.
