<b>Coordinating Conjunctions</b> (to make compound sentences)						
<i>and</i>	<i>but</i>	<i>so</i>	<i>for</i>	<i>yet</i>	<i>or</i>	<i>nor</i>
<b>Subordinating Conjunctions</b> (to make complex sentences)						
<i>after</i>	<i>although</i>	<i>as</i>	<i>as if</i>	<i>as long as</i>	<i>as soon as</i>	<i>as though</i>
<i>because</i>	<i>before</i>	<i>even (if)</i>	<i>even though</i>	<i>if</i>	<i>if only</i>	<i>in order that</i>
<i>just as</i>	<i>now</i>	<i>now that</i>	<i>once</i>	<i>provided</i>	<i>rather than</i>	<i>since</i>
<i>so that</i>	<i>than</i>	<i>that</i>	<i>though</i>	<i>unless</i>	<i>until</i>	<i>when</i>

<b>Relative Pronouns</b>

<b>For addition:</b>					<b>AND</b>
<i>and</i>	<i>also</i>	<i>too</i>	<i>plus</i>	<i>including</i>	
<i>in addition</i>	<i>as well as</i>	<i>together with</i>	<i>along with</i>	<i>not forgetting</i>	
<i>furthermore</i>	<i>moreover</i>	<i>another thing</i>	<i>what is more</i>	<i>notwithstanding</i>	
<b>To compare and contrast:</b>					<b>BUT</b>
<i>but</i>	<i>however</i>	<i>although</i>	<i>despite this</i>	<i>nevertheless</i>	
<i>whereas</i>	<i>alternatively</i>	<i>compared with</i>	<i>in contrast</i>	<i>on the other hand</i>	
<i>though</i>	<i>still</i>	<i>then again</i>	<i>apart from</i>	<i>and yet</i>	
<b>To show cause and effect:</b>					<b>SO</b>
<i>so</i>	<i>because (of this)</i>	<i>therefore</i>	<i>since</i>	<i>as a result</i>	
<i>so that</i>	<i>inevitably</i>	<i>consequently</i>	<i>in the same way</i>	<i>for this reason</i>	
<i>this causes</i>	<i>thanks to this</i>	<i>as a consequence</i>	<i>subsequently</i>	<i>this results in</i>	
<b>To signal time and sequence:</b>					<b>WHEN</b>
<i>earlier on</i>	<i>before</i>	<i>previously</i>	<i>during</i>	<i>meanwhile</i>	
<i>while</i>	<i>when</i>	<i>later</i>	<i>after</i>	<i>following</i>	
<i>last night</i>	<i>yesterday</i>	<i>today</i>	<i>tomorrow</i>	<i>next week</i>	
<b>To signal sequence:</b>					<b>THEN</b>
<i>Firstly,</i>	<i>First of all,</i>	<i>To begin with,</i>	<i>At the start,</i>	<i>Initially,</i>	
<i>Then,</i>	<i>Secondly,</i>	<i>After that,</i>	<i>Soon after,</i>	<i>Following this,</i>	
<i>Next,</i>	<i>Later on,</i>	<i>Afterwards,</i>	<i>Before long,</i>	<i>After a while,</i>	
<i>Last of all,</i>	<i>Finally,</i>	<i>At last,</i>	<i>In the end,</i>	<i>Eventually,</i>	
<b>To give opinion:</b>					<b>HOWEVER</b>
<i>however</i>	<i>despite this</i>	<i>even if</i>	<i>nevertheless</i>	<i>in spite of</i>	
<i>it would seem</i>	<i>it appears</i>	<i>on the other hand</i>	<i>whereas</i>	<i>even though</i>	
<i>maybe</i>	<i>perhaps</i>	<i>possibly</i>	<i>probably</i>	<i>it is likely</i>	
<b>For quantity:</b>					<b>SOME</b>
<i>nothing</i>	<i>none</i>	<i>some</i>	<i>few</i>	<i>a minority</i>	
<i>several</i>	<i>many</i>	<i>most</i>	<i>mainly</i>	<i>the majority</i>	
<b>For surprise or suspense:</b>					
<i>suddenly</i>	<i>that very moment</i>	<i>all of a sudden</i>	<i>without warning</i>	<i>in a flash</i>	
<i>out of nowhere</i>	<i>unexpectedly</i>	<i>however</i>	<i>unknown to them</i>	<i>secretly</i>	
<b>For dramatic effect:</b>					
<i>happily</i>	<i>fortunately</i>	<i>unbelievably</i>	<i>remarkably</i>	<i>frighteningly</i>	
<i>sadly</i>	<i>unfortunately</i>	<i>tragically</i>	<i>luckily</i>	<i>terrifyingly</i>	
<b>For emphasis and to persuade:</b>					
<i>the fact is</i>	<i>most agree that</i>	<i>some would argue</i>	<i>it is important to</i>	<i>naturally</i>	
<i>surely</i>	<i>clearly</i>	<i>obviously</i>	<i>of course</i>	<i>undoubtedly</i>	
<i>more importantly</i>	<i>especially</i>	<i>above all</i>	<i>indeed</i>	<i>in truth</i>	
<b>For illustration:</b>					
<i>such as</i>	<i>for example</i>	<i>for instance</i>	<i>in other words</i>	<i>as shown by</i>	
<i>to show that</i>	<i>this can be seen in</i>	<i>one example is</i>	<i>except for</i>	<i>unless</i>	
<b>For conclusion and summary:</b>					
<i>therefore</i>	<i>overall</i>	<i>after all</i>	<i>on the whole</i>	<i>on balance</i>
