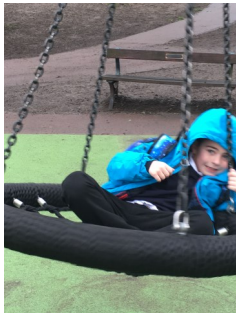


Green Class
