Task

1. How many beats in the bar does 'Crazy Glue' have? Can you sing it clapping on the down beat and tapping the rest?
2. Can you tell a grown up what a time signature tells you and what are the bars in music separated with?
3. Play the cup game again. Remember it has 2 beats.
4. Rewind the video to 15.12 and practice the 3-beat pulse to the different types of music.
5. We learnt a funny version of 'Happy birthday to you' can you sing it keeping the pulse by clapping and tapping?
6. Practice singing 'Found a peanut' keep the pulse going.
