



# HOT & COLD CLIMATES

The world can be divided into two halves. We call each half of the world a hemisphere. There is the Northern Hemisphere and the Southern Hemisphere. The imaginary line which divides the world into these two halves is called the Equator.

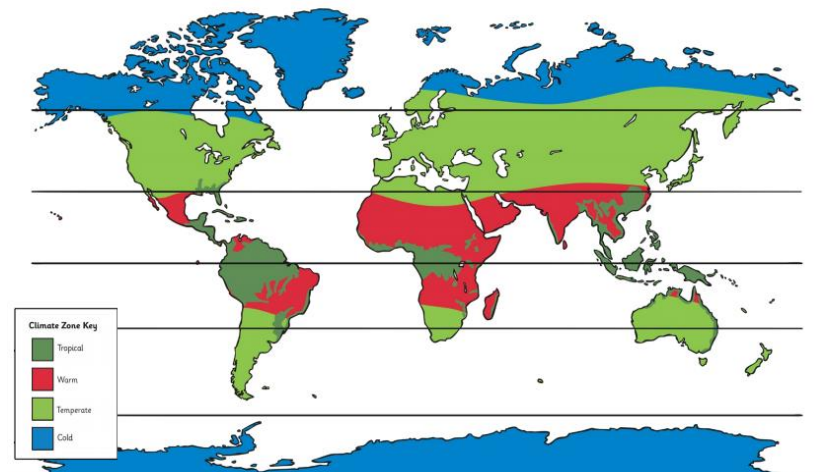

The closer a country is to the Equator line, the warmer the climate is. The further away from the Equator line, the colder the climate is.

We can split the world into 4 main climate groups:

- Cold or polar climate
- Warm climate
- Temperate climate
- Tropical climate
