School drop off and pick up information

We would like to invite parents to come onto the yard to drop off and collect your children. The timings that you have been given to drop off and collect your children will remain the same, this is so that we can get the children safely in and out of the school building while adhering to social distancing guidelines. Please can we ask you to line up on the yard as you previously did (whilst socially distancing) and wait for your child's year group to be called into school.

Year 1 - please drop off at 8.45 am and collect at 3.30pm (Friday 2.30pm)

Year 2 - please drop off at 8.40am and collect at 3.25pm (Friday 2.25pm)

Year 3 - please drop off at 8.50am and collect at 3.35pm (Friday 2.35pm)

Year 4 - please drop off at 8.45am and collect at 3.30pm (Friday 2.30pm)

Year 5 - please drop off at 8.40am and collect at 3.25pm (Friday 2.25pm)

Year 6 - please drop off at 8.35am and collect at 3.20pm (Friday 2.20pm)

Can we please ask parents to follow social distancing guidelines and try to maintain a 2m (where possible) distance from each other and respect each other's space.
