Reading (5 house points):

Write a book review of your favourite book! Why do you love it so much? What makes the characters so interesting? Who would you recommend it to? How many stars would you rate it? Read it to a member of your family (pets included!).

Writing (5 house points):

Every day, write a home diary about what you have been getting up to. Record in it, how you are feeling, what you loved about your day, what you didn't like about your day and what you can do to help to make your family smile!

Science (5 house points):

In Science, we were looking at what keeps us healthy. Can you explore the role of muscles in your body? Do 10, star jumps, sit ups, squats and lunges - which of your muscles did you use for each activity? Create a healthy menu for you and your family for the next week - have you included all of the main food groups?

Art (3 house points):

Linked with Geography, create your own Mardi Gras/carnival/festival Brazilian mask! Use any materials or resources that you can find around your house! You could also, sketch and paint your mask to show it in different mediums.

Then, think about how it compares to the UK, what is the same and what is different?
