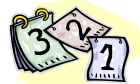


Important Dates

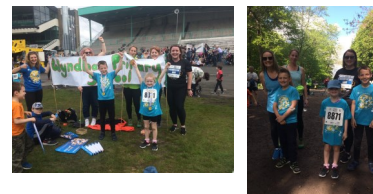
Wyndham Karate Kids!
