LATENESS!

Being late doesn’t only affect your child, it disrupts other children in the class as well as the teachers trying to teach a lesson. However, if you do think you are going to be late, please don’t keep your child off school for the rest of the day. Being late and in school is better than being absent and missing out. If a pupil arrives late to school but whilst the register is still open they are marked as late. According to Department for Education guidelines, registers will close at 9:20am. Therefore, if a student arrives after this time, they cannot receive a late mark but have to be marked as absent for the whole morning session. If the lateness is due to a legitimate reason e.g. a medical appointment, the absence can be authorised. Otherwise, the session is marked as an unauthorised absence. **Commencing Monday 18th June parents/carers must complete a 'Late Slip' at the main office on their child's arrival to school after 8:55am.** Good punctuality at school is essential for children to achieve their full educational potential. It is also vital for students to form good habits for later life.
