



## Top Ten Activities – Year 4

### Maths (5 house points)

How long does it take you to complete a multiplication grid? Can you beat your original time?  
Can you ask the people in your family their favourite sport and create a bar chart to show this information?  
Can you tell the time? What time was it an hour ago?  
What time will it be in half an hour?

### Art (3 house points)

Can you use materials from around the house to create your own Harry Potter collage?  
Can you draw a portrait of one of your family members?  
Can you use recycled materials to create a sculpture of your favourite TV character? Footballer? YouTuber? Etc.

### History (3 house points)

Find a clip that you are interested in about the Romans on: <https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zqtf34j>  
Create an information leaflet explaining what you have learned. Use the internet/books/newspapers to research the British royal family. What interesting facts can you find out? Can you write a biography about a member of the royal family?

### Reading (5 house points)

Read a chapter of your favourite book to your grown up before you go to sleep.  
How are the characters feeling? How do you know? Can you summarise what has happened so far in the chapter? What do you predict will happen next? Create a book review once you have finished the book.

### (8 house points)

Please practise reading and writing these words. How many sentences can you write including these words? Can you find these words in the dictionary and write their definition?

### Geography (3 house points)

In Geography, we have been looking at 'The Water Cycle'. Can you create a show for your family to explain the features of the Water Cycle? Maybe you could create your own model of the Water Cycle using recycled materials and label it? Can you list some of the causes of water pollution? How does water pollution affect plants and animals?

### Writing (5 house points)

How is the little girl feeling at the start of the clip? How does her mood change? Can you write your own instructions to tell people how to look after a giraffe?

### DT - Cooking (3 house points)

Help with the cooking and baking at home. Remember to carefully measure the ingredients! How much of each ingredient would you need if you were following the same recipe for 10, 100, 1000 people? Remember to taste and evaluate the finished product!

### Science (5 house points)

In Science, we have been looking at 'Sound'. Can you create your own string telephone using plastic cups and string?

How does sound change over distance? How does sound travel through the string telephone? Can you create a musical instrument using recycled materials?

### Community (3 house points)

Draw a picture that may make someone's day! Put it in the window so that passers-by can smile at your masterpiece!  
Try and do at least one act of kindness for someone every day.  
Make a list of everything that you have done. How many will you have on your list by the end of the week?

### PE (3 house points)

Follow 'The Body Coach TV' on YouTube and complete Joe Wicks' workout every morning at 9am. Can you create your own workout for your family to follow? Maybe they could record you and you could watch it back? How many star jumps/ press-ups/ squats can you do in two minutes?
