



Top Ten Activities – Year 2

Maths (5 house point activity)

Follow the daily lessons provided by White Rose Maths. Complete the revision sessions from the Spring term (weeks 1 and 2) before moving onto the Summer Term lessons. These are a series of videos followed by some example questions.

Reading (5 house point activity)

Continue to read as often as possible. See if you can find an author you love as much as Mr D'Evelin enjoys reading books by Julia Donaldson. Once you have completed each book take time to reflect on what happened, how the characters felt and your favourite part. You could even create a book review of your favourite story.

Writing (5 house point activity)

During the summer term in Year 2 we often try retelling stories in our own words. Try watching a short video clip and plot out the key events using a story map. Then try writing the story in your own words focusing on the key language features we have been working on in class (adjectives, joining conjunctions and time conjunctions).

Try creating a nature picture/collage using things which you can find whilst out on a walk. You could use anything from twigs, leaves, petals or even help with the weeding and use dandelions or daisies.

Try taking two photos on a phone or tablet then edit one using a filter so it's just black and white. Which version do you prefer?

Create a piece of artwork including all the colourful things in the world which you love.
