Wyndham Primary School Uniform Policy



Dark grey or black trousers, skirt, shorts, pinafore.

Green school sweatshirt or cardigan with school logo.

White polo shirt or shirt.

Dark grey, black, bottle green or white tights or socks.

Green checked or striped summer dress.

Sensible wide fitting black shoes; not trainers or boots. Shoes must have heels less than 2 cm.

For P.E. Black shorts, house colour t-shirt, sandals (no sports shoes needed for EY), sweat pants for outside and small P.E. bag for carrying clothes in.

Outlandish clothing or hairstyles are not acceptable for school. All pupils need to be clean and tidy to enable them to have the best possible opportunity to learn. The Head Teacher shall have the final say in deciding what is acceptable, so when in doubt parents should consult with her before buying items which might not be acceptable.
