School Meals

If your child is in KS2 and you wish to change your child's meal pattern you must give at least one week's notice or you will still have to pay for that period this is because food is ordered and purchased in advance for your child.

The cost of a school meal is £2.20 per day and must be paid on a Monday for the current week. Dinners can be paid by cheque or cash and popped into an envelope to give to your child then for your child to hand it into their class teacher.
