### A reminder about medicines in school.

In line with SMART MAT policy and government regulations, we must follow strict guidance around medicines in school to safeguard children. Therefore,

- We will only accept medicine prescribed to your child.
- All medication must be in the original packaging/box with the pharmacy label attached.
- All medication must be brought to the school office by an adult as your signature is required on an Individual Care Plan. This tells us what the medicine is for and how it should be taken.
- We may not accept medicine to be given three times a day as it can be given before school, straight after school and in the evening.

Please let us know immediately if your child's regular medication changes or their Individual Care Plan needs to be updated.

#### What to do:

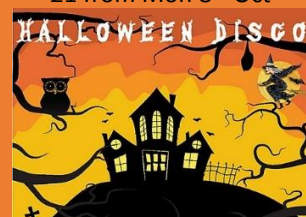
1. Rinse the empty 'pop' bottle
