LITERACY



Writing-

The children will take part in fiction writing this half term. We will be using 'Who Let the Gods Out?' as our main class story and using this to write our own narrative. In grammar lessons we will focus on using fronted adverbials, repetition, ellipsis and paragraphs to aid cohesion as well as modal verbs to indicate degrees of possibility. In punctuation lessons, we will focus on developing our use of direct and reported speech.



Reading- The children will take time completing comprehensions linking the genre of writing that we will be concentrating on in that week.

Phonics- This will happen daily linking to their spellings each week. We will continue to have a spellings test every **Friday**.

Homework

The children will receive reading books spellings and times tables. The children should read at least 3 times a week.

Spellings and times tables should be practiced in their homework book at least 3 times a week.
