LITERACY



Writing-

Children will take part in story writing based on the Jungle book. Children will adapt the original story and go on an adventure to Sri Lanka. Children will continue their work on commas, conjunctions and now apostrophes.



Reading- Children will make predictions about the title of the book, the character, what will happen in the story. The children will take time completing comprehensions linking the genre of writing that we will be concentrating on in that week. Children will take part in guided reading sessions.

Phonics- Will happen daily linking to spellings.

PSHCE

We will be celebrating and recognising our differences.

Homework

The children will receive reading books, spellings and times tables. The children should read at least 3 times a week. Spellings should be practiced in their homework book. On occasions your child may receive times tables homework.
