CHARTWELLS NUTRITION WORKSHOPS

Following three days of workshops with KS2 pupils, Chartwells hosted a school meal information parent workshop. Here's a few key facts about school meals you may have missed!

- ◇ All dishes are prepared and cooked fresh every single day
- ◇ All recipes and menus approved by a team of Nutritionists to ensure they are balanced, nutritious and support a child's development at school
- ◇ Menus are compliant with the School Food Standards set by the Government
- ◇ Every day there is a salad bar pupils can help themselves to, including bread which is freshly baked on site daily
- ◇ No added salt is used during cooking
- ◇ We have reduced the sugar content of desserts by 30%. This has been achieved through reformulation, reduction in portion sizes and increasing number of fruit-based desserts

SPONSOR A CHILD

As you will know, Salisbury Primary is in partnership with Mbollet-Ba, a school in The Gambia and some of you may have been lucky enough to visit there. As you may be aware, some of the children there are not as lucky as our pupils and it is difficult for their parents to find enough money to send their children to school. Jenny Brown, one of our previous Deputy Headteachers, is now working with Our Global School and Salisbury to organise for each year group to sponsor a child. It costs £36 to send a child to school for one year. This includes the family being able to buy the child school shoes, uniform, a school bag and some books and pencils - also including a contribution towards a school lunch of mealie meal.

Sponsor children will stay with your child's year group until the end of Year 6 or once the child has finished primary. Salisbury pupils will keep in contact with their sponsored classmate and send/receive letters and updates. There is a lot to learn about children going to school in a different country and some things will really surprise our children. Once we have set up a parent pay link, we will let you know so you can donate. If we receive more than £36, we will use the excess money for future years' sponsorship or if possible sponsor more than one child.

We appreciate that many of you already donate your money, items and time to Salisbury and other charities, so only donate if you can.

BURNS NIGHT CEILIDH

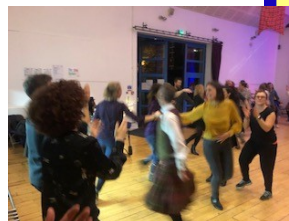
