

## ANSWERS

- 1) **PARISH** - Found on the bottom left of the map
- 2) **MOCKBA** - Written in capitals
- 3) **PEARL** - Written on the wall plaque next to the barbers
- 4) **SNAIL** – On the post nearest to Waitrose and the picnic tables
- 5) **LANE** - Written in black at the top of the post
- 6) **SUSTAINABLE** - on the manufacturers silver plaque
- 7) **LLTMNTGRDNS** - Allotment Gardens without the vowels
- 8) **270000** = Sum of 600 X 450
- 9) **PTCA** - Postal Telegraph Clerks Association written by the fountain
- 10) **WATER**- ‘W’ from surname Glue, ‘A’ from surname North, TER from the word Lottery which is underneath the crossed fingers
- 11) **CIA** - This is on the red square to the top left of the waiting room window
- 12) **12** - This is the house number of TC (Tudor Cottage). TOG is The Old Granary, next door to Tudor Cottage.
- 13) **CGFD**- 1842-1922 = 3764  
3 = C, 7 = G, 6 = F, 4 = D
- 14) **CIVIC** – In the porch / alley of the house next to the carpark
- 15) **KEYS** – On the large white all of the Red Lion pub
- 16) **CENTENARY** - On the plaque inside the Pepperpot
- 17) **GEORGIA** - On the plaque in the alley by the side of the museum
- 18) **1663** - On a white oval in the middle of the building
- 19) **TYLERS** - Written above the letter box by Snappy Snaps
- 20) **1836** - Located on the wall between Boots Opticians and Vision Express
