



PE & Sports Grant 2015-16

How much funding did we receive?

We have received £4,999 in the autumn term and a further £3,571 in the summer term giving us a total of **£8,570**.

What will we use this funding for?

Activity	Cost	Impact
Equipment – Hollow Blocks.	£2,060	Hollow blocks were used in Reception classes to improve gross motor skills, balance and co-ordination.
Equipment – Astroturf	£1,228	Has allowed children to use this outside space all year round.
Training – Dance Workshop	£150	Enhanced class teachers' knowledge of dance enabling them to further incorporate this subject into PE, enabling the children to have more varied teacher-led lessons.
Training – Shackleford Dance	£100	
Training – NQT Training	£169	Enhanced newly qualified teacher's subject knowledge.
Training – Sports Conference	£180	Allows the subject lead to enhance their skills and knowledge of PE and enables them to network with other local school and PE leaders to enhance our PE teaching. Also allows access additional PE resources and equipment.



Transportation to sporting events	£375	Allowed children to participate in various sporting activities over and above what is prescribed in the National Curriculum.
Contribution to Pepperpot	3,000	Allows children to improve gross motor skills, balance, co-ordination and climbing skills in a fun way in both PE lessons and at playtimes.
SCL – PE specialists	£1,325	Provided training to teachers to enable them to deliver more varied PE lessons, as well as delivering additional lessons to children.
