How much funding did we receive?

We received £8,555.

What did we use the funding and what was the impact?

Activity	Cost	Impact
Training - SCL sport coaching	£200	Enhanced class teachers' knowledge of PE leading to more varied teacher-led PE lessons.
Training – Subject leader training	£180	Allows the subject lead to enhance their skills and knowledge of PE and enables them to network with other local school and PE leaders to enhance our PE teaching. Also allows access additional PE resources and equipment.
Equipment – gym mats	£980	Additional gym mats enabled all children to participate safely and with enough space in indoor activities such as dance and gymnastics.
Equipment – general PE resources	£500	Replaced equipment which was old and damaged and bought new equipment to support curriculum.
Transport – coach travel to sporting events (x2)	£350	Enabled children to participate in a range of sports activities at other location which would not otherwise be available to them.
Safety inspection to ensure all PE equipment is safe and fit for purpose	£540	As stated.
SCL – PE specialists	£5,805	Allowed children to have specialist PE coaching once a week, for each year group, leading to enhanced skills in a range of sports including athletics,



		<p>gymnastics, net and wall games and dance. All children participated well and made good progress in their PE activities. Evidence was based on class observations, individual child reports from SCL and child feedback. All children were able to participate well in Sports Day and compete effectively in a number of different activities, based on their PE learning throughout the year.</p>
