The song of the week is Head Shoulders Knees & Toes so the class were talking about the body and looked at a skeleton on the lightbox!



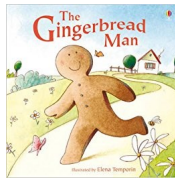
Red Class
