

Topic Theme and Overview: During a term of learning linked to the Rainforest, children will be learning about an artist called Henri Rousseau and his techniques of paintings. We will be painting rainforest scenes in the style of a famous artist.

Vocabulary:

Henri Rosseau, style, technique, paint, strokes, background, sketch, plan.

Tasks/activities informed by National Curriculum:

- Introduce images of Henri Rosseau and imagine what he is famous for.
- Look at selection of his work and discuss his techniques and style.
- Design own painting in style of Henri and list what we are going o include including colours, paintbrushes, etc.
- Children sketch their painting
- Children paint their picture in style of artist.
- Evaluate work and compare to artist.
