Dear parents and carers,

Following the great success of our annual 'Broadway Book Swap' and our aim to instil the love of reading into all of our children, we have decided to make the Book Swap a permanent feature in school.

The Book Swap will be situated in the main entrance hall and will consist of book shelves containing books sorted into year group phases (Early Years, Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2).

The idea is that children can bring in unwanted books into school and they can swap them for another book on the shelf. Children will tell their teacher when they need to do this and they will be supported to swap their books at a convenient time and to make an appropriate choice. Our super Year 4 Reading Ambassadors will be on hand to assist children in finding a new book that they will enjoy.

To get the Book Swap started, we would really welcome any donations of books that your children have finished with to get the stock going. These can be fiction, non-fiction or poetry. Please send them into school with your child and they can pass them on to their class teacher.

We will start the Book Swap after half term but please send in old books before **Thursday 25th October 2018**.

From **Monday 5th November 2018**, children will be able to bring in a book to swap. The rule will be to bring in one book at a time and to take one book in return.

We are really looking forward to getting started and giving the children the opportunity to read and enjoy more books!
