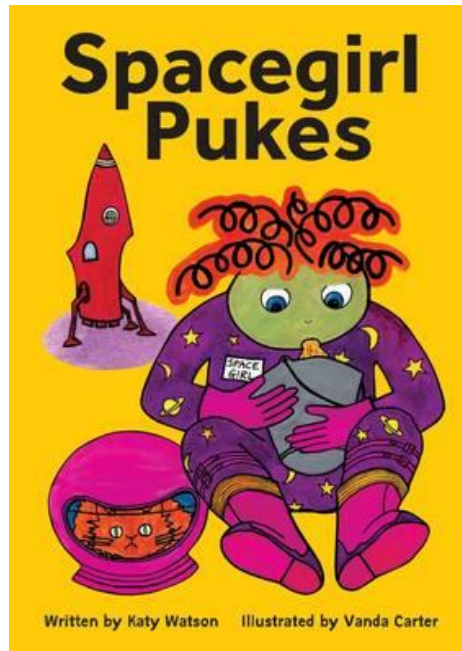

Spacegirl has her own rocket ship so she can fly to the stars. Here's a picture of Spaceregirl's rocket ship.

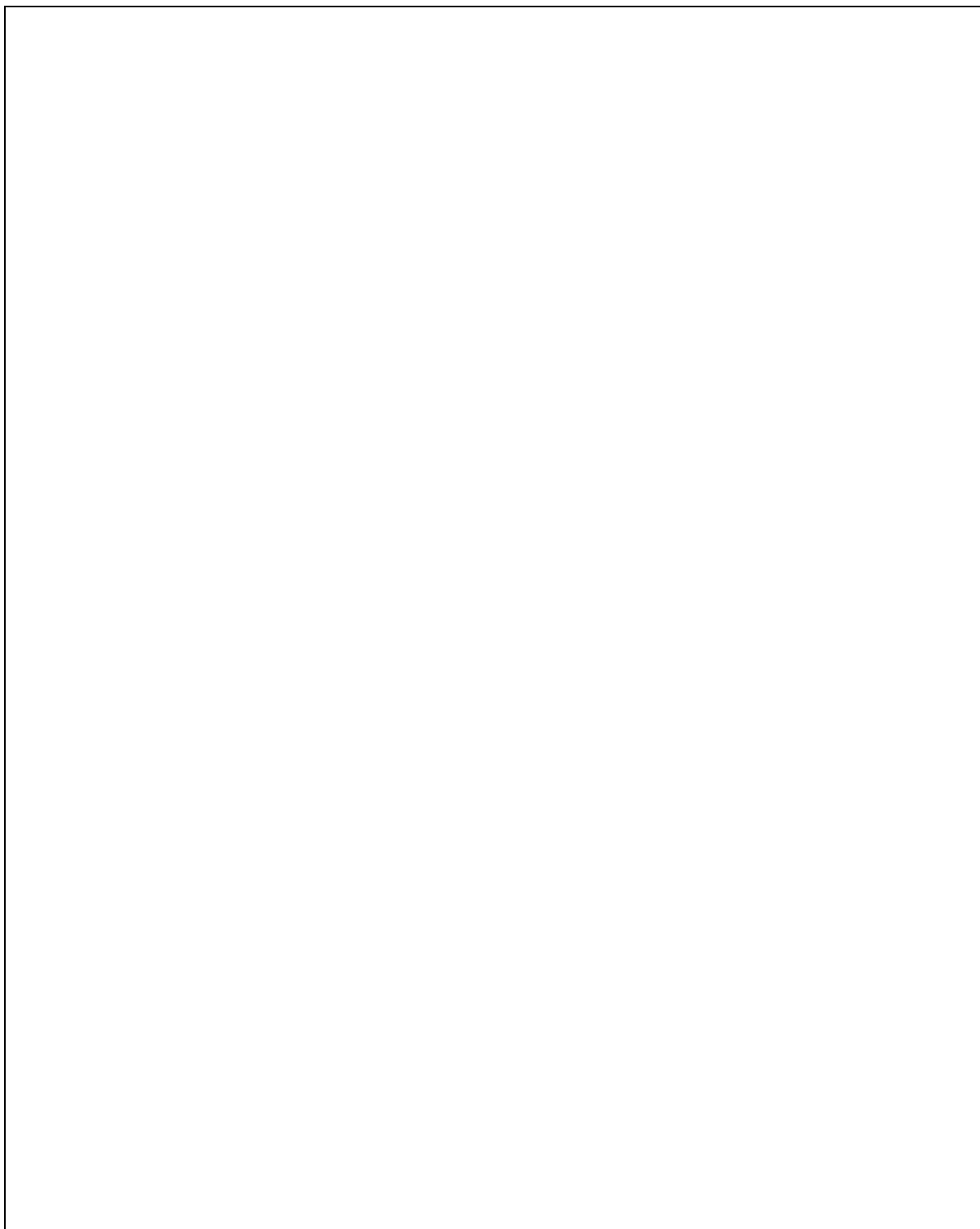


If you had a rocket ship, what would it look like? Draw your own rocket ship in the box below.



When Spacegirl is sick, who looks after her? Spacegirl's two mummies take good care of her.

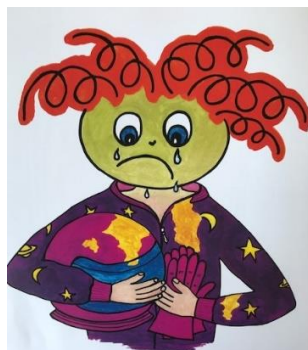


Who takes care of you when you are sick? Draw and label the people here.


