Part B: Assessment Stage

Items 1 - 5 of the application stage criteria and the criteria below will be further explored at the assessment stage:

Essential

1	An understanding and ability to set realistic and challenging targets and be able to assess and review learners' progress.
2	Ability to communicate effectively with children, young people, colleagues and parents/carers.
3	Able to engage and motivate learners in the school environment.
4	Able to contribute to and support the development of the curriculum in one or more areas.

5	Have positive values and attitudes and have high expectations for learners.
6	Be a positive role model for learners.
7	Be aware of current legislation, policies and guidance on the safeguarding of learners and the promotion of their well-being.
8	Able to work collaboratively as member of a team and contribute to the professional development of colleagues, including sharing effective practice.
9	Able to plan, organise and prioritise time effectively.
10	Outstanding verbal and interpersonal skills, including the ability to use standard and grammatically correct English in writing and speaking.
11	Commitment to developing the curriculum provision through extra-curricular activities.
12	Able to effectively contribute to whole school improvement priorities.

Desirable

13 A willingness and ability to teach across the first school age range.

The following methods of assessment will be used:

- Short listing from paper applications
- Lesson observations
- Further short listing following observations
- Interviews and paper-based activities

Part C: Additional Requirements

The following criteria must be judged as satisfactory when pre-employment checks are completed:

2	Additional criminal record checks if applicant has lived outside the UK
3	List 99 and/or POCA List (residential establishments only) check
4	Qualified teacher Status
5	Two references from current and previous employers. You must use your current employer if you are in employment at the present time or your most recent if you are not in employment.
6	Medical clearance
7	A good attendance record
