We will be working in pairs and small groups to take part in problem solving activities to promote teamwork.

We will be talking about people who help us and how we can help others.

We will share our experiences of visiting the beach and talk about how to stay safe.

Communication and Language

We will be following instructions when following our maps to find treasure.

We will use language to imagine and recreate roles in our ice cream parlour role play. We will also retell our own stories and familiar stories in our small world area.

We will be learning new topic related vocabulary and describing characters in our stories.

Physical Development

We will develop our fine motor skills with our finger challenges and practice forming our letters correctly.

In PE, we will be developing our ball skills further through our football sessions with Newcastle United Foundation.

We will also use outdoor learning time to develop gross and fine motor skills. We will be completing pirate training by practising our speed, balance and strength on our obstacle courses.

Literacy

This term we will be reading stories including; 'Zog', 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch' and 'What the Ladybird Heard at the Seaside'.

We will write a description about 'Zog', as well as writing instructions about how to be a good dragon.

We will write a plan to stop the seagulls from eating Mr Grinling's lunch.

We will also be labelling key landmarks on a treasure map and writing our own message in a bottle.

We will be writing simple sentences, focusing on finger spaces, full stops and capital letters.

EYFS Summer Term 2

Dragons and The Seaside

Understanding the World

We will find out about the different parts of a castle.

We will explore a variety of materials to build a lifeboat that floats in the water tray.

We will be learning about Grace Darling and how Lifeguards keep us safe at the beach.

We will also be programming bee-bots.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will design and build our own castles, using a range of resources.

We will be mixing colours to paint and design our own dragons.

We will build our own lighthouse models, as well as creating seaside collages.

Mathematics

This term the children will learn that double means 'twice as many'. They will be given opportunities to build doubles using real objects and mathematical equipment. We will be learning to recall doubles. We will also be sharing groups of objects and halving.

We will explore odd and even number this half term. The children will begin to understand that some quantities will share equally into 2 groups and some won't. We will be exploring the odd and even structure on the number shapes and building pair-wise patterns on the 10 frames.
