Dear Parents and Carers,

In school, we follow the White Rose Maths Hub Schemes of Work as a guide for our long, medium and short term planning. The White Rose Maths Hub have developed home learning activities linked to key objectives from each year group of the National Curriculum. There is a session provided each day which follows the format of a short video lesson and then an activity to complete. There are also answers to the activities so the children can see where they have been successful or identify any misconceptions they may have had within the activity. The booklets can be printed off, or if this is not possible, then they can be read on screen and answered on paper or in the exercise books that we sent home. We suggest that the children complete all of the daily tasks for each week they are away from school. There are five lessons per week and one per day would be ideal.

In addition to this, there are maths activities signposted on our website where children can enjoy fun mathematical puzzles and games that require problem solving and thinking skills to complete. Teachers may also set additional maths challenges through class Twitter accounts. Remember there are many opportunities to use maths every day from identifying numbers and counting to telling the time and related questions associated with this activity. Older children, can work on Multiplication tables and specifically TT Rockstars where they can challenge each other and even their teachers!

We hope that the children enjoy these activities and that they help you to support learning in Maths at home.
